### Admission Process and Instructions

Bradford Christian Academy welcomes your application. Please read the following steps carefully before returning the completed application packet. Applications are being accepted on a rolling admissions basis. To be considered for the first round of decisions that will be announced in mid-March, the application packet should be completed and sent to BCA by Monday, February 15, 2010. Applications received after this deadline will be reviewed and decided upon by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month following receipt.

- Application for Admissions – Parents complete and sign the Application for Admissions form, enclose \$50 (U.S.) or \$150 (international students) non-refundable application fee and mail to: Bradford Christian Academy, Attn: Admissions, 97 Oxford Avenue, Bradford, MA 01835, USA
- Statement of Faith – Parents and applicant sign and return with the Application.
- Math Teacher Evaluation – Give the Evaluation to the applicant’s current Math Teacher. Provide this teacher with a stamped envelope addressed to Bradford Christian Academy. ***Fifth grade applicants need only 1 teacher evaluation.***
- English Teacher Evaluation – Give the Evaluation to the applicant’s current English Teacher. Provide this teacher with a stamped envelope addressed to Bradford Christian Academy.
- Pastor Recommendation (Pastor or Non-Family Adult) – Give the Recommendation to the applicant’s Pastor, Youth Pastor/Leader, Sunday School Teacher or other Non-Family Adult who knows the applicant outside of the school setting. Provide this person with a stamped envelope addressed to Bradford Christian Academy.
- Parent/Guardian Statement – Parents complete and return with the Application.
- Student Application – Student completes and returns with the Application.
- Student Record Release Form – Parents complete, sign and **forward to the applicant’s current school.**
- Tuition and Financial Aid Information – Parents review.

U.S. Students - Arrange for the applicant entering grades 5-8 to take the BCA administered entrance exam by calling 978-373-7900. Arrange for the applicant entering grades 9-12 to take the SSAT (Secondary School Admission Test) by accessing [www.ssat.org](http://www.ssat.org) or calling 609-683-4440 and have the results sent directly to BCA (1785).  
International Students – Applicants entering grades 5-8 should email [jcram@bradfordchristianacademy.org](mailto:jcram@bradfordchristianacademy.org) to request test materials. Arrange for the applicant entering grades 9-12 to take the SSAT in the student’s country by accessing [www.ssat.org](http://www.ssat.org) or calling 609-683-4440 and have the results sent directly to BCA (1785). The SLEP is required as well. Information regarding the SLEP is available through your overseas education agency.

### Registration Process

Upon admittance and acceptance, a \$500 non-refundable enrollment fee (applicable toward tuition) is due per student. You will receive a registration packet to complete and return promptly.

## **Financial Aid 2010–2011 School Year**

Bradford Christian Academy uses the services of an independent organization, FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment, to determine a family's need for financial aid. Financial aid decisions are made on the basis of parental financial need and availability of funds. The financial aid application process begins January 4, 2010 and forms must be submitted by April 30, 2010. Notification of financial aid decisions will begin in March. Financial aid is awarded on a first come, first served basis, therefore you are encouraged to submit your completed application as soon as possible. Admissions applications should be submitted simultaneously with the financial aid application to ensure the availability of a class position upon acceptance. Bradford Christian Academy's admission decisions are made independent of the financial aid process.

*Synopsis:* Two parts: 25 minute essay not scored by SSAT, but forwarded to school; and a multiple choice aptitude test including two math sections, one reading comprehension section, and one verbal section including 30 synonyms and 30 analogies

*Scores:* Report sent to schools within 2 weeks of test date and sent to home within 3 weeks

\*Bradford Christian Academy's SSAT **school code** number is **1785**.

\*\*We recommend that every applicant taking the SSAT complete the sample practice test online at [www.ssat.org](http://www.ssat.org). It will familiarize your child with the test format and questions similar to those on the SSAT. You may also purchase a practice book for \$22 that includes two full-length practice tests.
