



Financial Aid 2012–2013 School Year

To Parents of New and Returning BCA Students applying for Financial Aid:

Bradford Christian Academy uses the services of an independent organization, FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment, to determine a family's yearly need for financial aid. Financial aid decisions are made on the basis of parental financial need and availability of funds. The financial aid application process begins November 15, 2011. Please note that a financial aid application cannot be considered for families whose application materials are incomplete or whose BCA 2011-2012 tuition account is not current. All families who wish to be considered for financial aid must do the following:

- **New Students** - Submit a complete admissions application to the Admissions Coordinator. Bradford Christian Academy's admissions decisions are made independent of the financial aid process, therefore a student must be accepted prior to receiving the financial aid award.
- **Returning Students** – Re-enrollment begins January 2, 2012. Returning families must complete the re-enrollment paperwork and submit to BCA with a \$500 re-enrollment deposit by January 25, 2012.
 - Complete the FACTS Tuition Aid application at www.factstuitionaid.com by February 10, 2012. (New student applications should be submitted simultaneously with the financial aid application). There is a \$20 non-refundable financial aid application fee payable to FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment.
 - Student's parents living in separate households must each submit financial information. Notification of financial aid decisions will begin February 20, 2012.

Yearly awards are based on the availability of funds. New student financial aid applications submitted after the first deadline (see Financial Aid Timeline) will be considered and awards given if funds are still available. The demonstrated need of our families may exceed our available financial aid funds each year.

Families will need to re-apply for financial aid each year.
